What will we be doing?: Fall, winter, and spring are collectively

termed the "soup" season. During this time, the soup plant is active and volunteers can participate in mixing and bagging soup mix. Others may assist with sorting and preparing items for shipment. In addition to the soup production, there are numerous opportunities for service all over the base. Maintenance tasks include painting, landscaping, kitchen assistance, housekeeping, automotive and machinery repair, repairing fruit drying trays, and bucket washing. The quilt room is open for anyone who would like to make (or learn how to make) quilts. Occasionally, there will be special projects such as new construction, event planning, etc.
