Our purpose is to share God's love with those in our community who are looking for food assistance. We strive to provide a sense of dignity and respect to those we serve. To that end, we have designed our pantry to operate like a grocery store, allowing customers to select their own food from our pantry shelves. This provides a feeling of normalcy to our guests while cutting waste from unwanted or unneeded food.

In addition to providing weekly grocery/toiletry allotments, we also go one step deeper. Along with conversation and prayer, people are offered a Bible (We provide English and Spanish) and Bible study courses. In the effort to build bridges to the church, show the love of Jesus, and to open doors for a deeper relationship, the food pantry team also provides information about church services, midweek, youth ministries, and upcoming church events.

Our Food Pantry is open every Thursday from 7:30am to 9:30am (Closed the week of Thanksgiving, Christmas, and Easter; and every fifth Thursday of a month.)
