Opening...

Background...

- Skim Acts 1:1-2:35. What key events have just happened?
- Read Acts 2:36-41. The church goes from about 120 to 3000 in one day! What problems or concerns might this situation create for this community? What opportunities?

Study...

- Read Acts 2:42-47.
- According to verse 42, what things did these new believers "devote" themselves to and why?
- How do each of these components meet a different growth need in their lives?
- What else did these new believers do? What was their attitude?
- What effect did this new community have on those around them? Why was that, do you think?

Think about it...

- How is First Pres like this early church? How is it different? (think about the FP mission of knowing, loving, blessing)
- What are some ways our congregation (or the Church in Kern County or in America) could express the kind of devotion that leads to transformation as we see in this passage?
- What personal practices could **you** incorporate into your own life to live more fully into God's kingdom and his Church?
- Pray that we could be this kind of community of faith in our world today!
