When we read the Bible, and especially when we read the Christmas narratives in the gospels, we tend to think of them as individual stories (and wonderful stories they are)! But let's remember that the Word of God is ONE STORY... a beautiful story of a once-perfect, now broken world in desperate need of rescue and renewal. That's why Jesus came. He came to fix broken people, broken relationships, and our broken world. He came to make everything good and new again, like it was in the beginning.

By reading the following Scripture passages each day in December, your family will start with CREATION and journey through the OLD TESTAMENT, tracing God's recurring promise to rescue us. The stories will end on Christmas Day, with the long-anticipated arrival of the Promised Son. I encourage you to find your favorite children's Bible or Picture Bible (or use a different Bible each day), and spend a few minutes as a family each day celebrating the grace and goodness of our amazing God.
