Preschool kids-

Shepherd on the Search: An "Elf on the Shelf" alternative! Hide the shepherd around your house each day of December and complete activity cards together as you also read the biblical account of Jesus' birth. Many Options available for additional pieces such as book, camel, ornaments, etc. I suggest Christianbook.com for the best price. There's also a FB group for ideas!

Shepherds Treasure Set : Similar to "Shepherd on the Search" as an "Elf on the Shelf" alternative. Also comes with a small baby Jesus doll, activity cards and Scripture to read with your children all month. As a bonus, this set also has an "Easter" add -on to use this same concept during Lent with a stuffed sheep. Join the FB group for ideas!

Miracle In a Manger: a Plush doll, Book to read and activity cards with Scripture to read each day as a family. At the beginning of the month, the Angel doll visits your home with an empty manger, and on Christmas morning, baby Jesus arrives in the manger. A precious tradition for your young children! Elementary Kids-

Truth in the Tinsel—available as an ebook, a passage of Scripture is read each day, and a simple ornament (patterns included in ebook) is made as a reminder. Great for older preschool and younger elementary. (TruthInTheTinsel.com)

The Giving Manger: similar to "Miracle in a Manger" but smaller in scale, with real straw, so more appropriate for older kids (bigger hands). Help your children focus on giving rather than receiving! TheGivingManger.com (\$40)
