What will we be doing?: Every summer, packers from the Central Valley donate their cull peaches and nectarines. From June through the end of August, over 1,200 youth from all over California, other states, and Canada, come to process the fruit. It takes approximately 80 people to run the fruit line efficiently. Fruit must also be picked up from the field after being dried. Working in the California heat is a character building experience for most teams that come to serve.

What Not to Bring:

- iPods/iPads/Tablets/Kindles, etc.

Sulfur Alert: There is a light dusting of sulfur is placed on the peaches before they go into the field to dry. If anyone has allergies to sulfur, we ask that they use caution if they plan on participating in our ministry.
